INFLATION REDUCTION ACT (IRA)

- Federal Law passed in August 2022
- Nearly \$400 Billion for clean energy
 - \$8.8 Billion for allocated for Home Energy Efficiency & Electrification
 - Home Efficiency Rebates Program (HOMES)
 - Home Electrification & Appliance Rebates Program (HEAR)
 - Indiana Allocated \$182 Million
 - Indiana Office of Energy Development (OED)
 - Egis, third-party administrator

ELIGIBLE EQUIPMENT

- Electric heat pump for cooling and heating
- Electric heat pump water heater
- Electric heat pump clothes dryer
- Electric stove, cooktop, range, oven
- Electric panel, wiring upgrades
- Building envelope
 - Insulation
 - Air, duct sealing
- (potentially) Other energy savings technologies
 - Ventilation improvements (kitchen hood)
 - Thermostats


HOME ELECTRIFICATION & APPLIANCE REBATES PROGRAM (HEAR)

- Area Median Income (AMI)
- Households with income above 80% of AMI
 - Household income must be below 150% of AMI
 - 50% of costs up to \$14,000
- Households with income below 80% of AMI
 - **100%** of costs up to \$14,000
- Multi-Family/Rental Housing Building Owner
 - More than 50% of households must be below 150% of AMI
 - 50% of costs up to \$14,000/unit
- Low-Income Multi-Family/Rental Housing Bldg. Owner
 - More than 50% of households <u>below</u> 80% of AMI
 - Lesser of 100% of project costs or \$14,000/unit

HOME EFFICIENCY REBATES PROGRAM (HOMES)

- Households with income above 80% of AMI
 - 20-34% energy savings, 50% of costs up to \$2,000
 - 35% or greater energy savings, 50% of costs up to \$4,000
- Households with income below 80% of AMI
 - 20-34% energy savings, 80% of costs up to \$4,000
 - 35% or greater energy savings, 80% of costs up to \$8,000
- Multi-Family/Rental Housing Building Owner
 - 20-34% energy savings, \$2,000/unit up to \$200,000
 - **35%** or greater energy savings, \$4,000/unit up to \$400,000
- Low-Income Multi-Family/Rental Housing Bldg. Owner
 - More than 50% of households below 80% of AMI
 - 20-34% energy savings, 80% of costs up to \$4,000/unit
 - 35% or greater energy savings, 80% of costs up to \$8,000/unit
